The Equality and Human Rights Commission is delighted to share with you our new interactive tool for learning about the **Human Rights Act**. [Dignity Drive](#) puts each of the Articles of the Act into an everyday context by looking at how they affect real people and why they are therefore so important.



In **Dignity Drive** each of the residents has a story to tell about how the Human Rights Act protects their rights. At each home you will find a case study, and real life examples of how human rights can make a difference to ordinary people. Some of the residents have films to show you of what a human rights approach looks like in different organisations.

Last year, our [Human Rights Inquiry](#) found that a human rights approach can lead to a better quality of life for many people, better public service delivery, as well improving organisational effectiveness and enhancing staff morale. A first step for developing a human rights approach could be to use **Dignity Drive** to raise awareness of human rights within your organisation.
