At Dyfodol we believe that **peer-education** is one of the best methods to communicate issues and ideas so the course will focus on the participants going back to their school/organisation/local community to **deliver their own projects** on sustainability to their peers... By the end of the course the participants will be advocates of sustainable development and ready to take action! We will also provide training on aspects of **project planning and organising** as well as background sessions on the **sustainability issues** the young people want to focus on. The young people's training will be run by a mixture of Dyfodol staff as well as our own trained young peer-educators!

Alongside the young people's workshops we'll be running **teacher and youth worker training** on how to implement Education for Sustainable Development and Global Citizenship (ESDGC) into your organisation. We'll be focusing on skill sharing and building on good practice - but also helping you to discover new and easy ways to get ESDGC happening in your school/organisation. One successful way of doing this is by supporting

the young people to do it! So we'll also **be working together** with them at points to build truly sustainable projects.

- All days will run from 10am until 3pm. Free lunch will be provided.
- You're asked to attend both days with the same young people as we'll be building work together over the course of 2 days.
