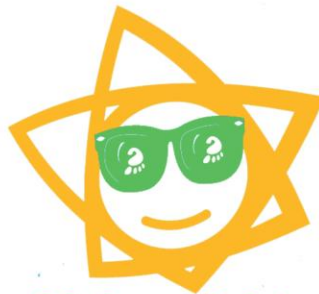




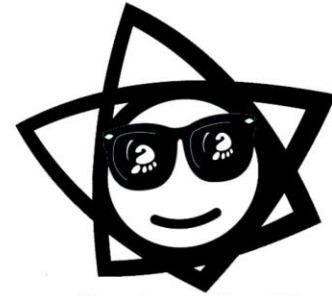

This is a vital advancement for your organisation at a time when we are being told to reduce our carbon footprints. It is also clear that organisations will need to rethink their strategies and reconsider the services they are providing - will they be fit for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century?

The session is informative, fun and practical. You will learn a great deal whilst supporting the movement for change. Chwarea Teg, Scope Cymru and Disability Wales have all taken part – the sessions were stimulating, engaging and thoughtful for all involved.


The workshop can be based within your own premises or in SW's training room, but must involve representatives including staff, management (trustees/directors) and volunteers. Work sheets, presentation, participation and supporting resources will help you to improve your policies & practices.

A speaker from Cardiff University has been asked to outline the potential local effects and risks to your organisation from an increase in global temperature, which brings this international issue back home.

As already mentioned an independently produced carbon audit can also be provided. This carbon footprint measurement will record the actual impact that results directly from work activities, including travel and energy use.
